SUBJECT: FUND 266 – NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM GRANT AGREEMENT

PCAO requests the approval of the National Criminal History Improvement Program Grant Agreement, ACJC Grant Number NCP16-17-005 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and Pinal County, through the Pinal County Attorney's Office, to commence on October 1, 2016 and terminate on December 31, 2017 in the amount of \$122,304 to improve the quality and completeness of criminal history record systems. The grant award includes required matching funds of \$12,203 to be met by the Pinal County Attorney's Office Criminal Justice Enhancement Funds (Fund 181). The grant award will provide funding for temporary legal support employees to update case outcomes in conjunction with the Arizona Disposition Reporting System implementation project underway in the Pinal County Attorney's Office.

The acceptance of the National Criminal History Improvement Grant requires approval of an amendment to the FY 2016-2017 budget for 9 months of the grant period of October 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. The appropriation designates an increase of \$73,382 in revenue and expenditures in Fund 266 and a transfer of \$7,338 from Fund 181 to Fund 266. The remaining grant award and fund transfer will be appropriated within the FY 2017-2018 budget. There is no impact to the General Fund.
