RE: Senior Services for the City of Apache Junction

Dear Mr. House,

As a result of our prior conversation, you are aware that several months ago our local nonprofit organization, East Valley Adult Resources, informed the city that they are no longer able to provide senior services at our Multigenerational Center. Those services include congregate meals, meals on wheels, transportation and other social programs for our seniors in need. The last day of their services will be November 11, 2016. Over the last several months our Parks and Recreation department has worked very closely with Pinal-Gila Area Agency on Aging. We anticipate from November 11, 2016 to June 30, 2017 that Pinal-Gila Area Agency on Aging will be providing these similar services to our community via contract.

Our Parks and Recreation department has concluded that in order to meet minimum service deliveries for this time frame that we will need \$18,000.00. We respectfully request that you and the Pinal County Board of Directors consider a one-time expenditure from the county to assist us in our time of need.

We thank you in advance for your consideration. It is my goal to provide our mayor and city council a plan to provide their services the best we can for the 2017-2018 fiscal year starting on July 1, 2017.
